### Advantages of UV Wash

- Contains emulsifiers, so water can be mixed into the wash to clean solvent-soluble residue and water-soluble residue
- Formulated to clean the blanket or roller thoroughly of either hybrid inks or UV cured inks\* without harming the rubber surface
- Uses high flashpoint solvents, whose slower evaporation rate means more economical use – solvents do not flash off so rapidly, remaining on the rubber surface to dissolve ink
  - \* includes UV cured newsink e.g. Flint Group Arrowlith. Not suitable for conventional inks
